1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Aging - Comprehensive Plan for the Aging Population

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Aging, in consultation with certain other 4 units, to develop a comprehensive long-term plan to address the impacts and needs 5 of the State's aging population; requiring the Department, in developing the plan, to 6 examine certain impacts, identify certain resource or service gaps, consider provision 7 of some services on a regional basis, evaluate certain measures, develop certain 8 recommendations, and identify certain benchmarks; requiring the plan to include a 9 summary of certain impacts and needs, a description of certain resource or service gaps, certain recommendations, and certain benchmarks; requiring the Department, 10 11 on or before a certain date and annually thereafter until completion of the plan, to 12 submit a progress report to the General Assembly; requiring the Department to 13 submit the completed plan to the Governor and the General Assembly, continue to 14 consult with certain units, evaluate implementation of the plan, and annually update 15 the plan; and generally relating to planning for the impacts and needs of the aging population. 16

- 20 UNTIL COMPLETION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 21 SUBMIT A PROGRESS REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH §
- 22 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.
