#### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Election Judges – Training and Signs – Accommodations for Voters in Need of Assistance

FOR the purpose of requiring that training materials used by the program of instruction
for election judges include oral and written instruction in the various methods an
election judge may use to assist or accommodate elderly and disabled voters in
voting; establishing requirements for the development and placement of a sign that
states the various methods election judges may use to assist or accommodate elderly
and disabled voters in voting; and generally relating to accommodations for voters
in need of assistance and election judges.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
   That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
