BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Transportation Section 16-816 Annotated Code of Maryland (2020 Replacement Volume and 2022 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Transportation 16-816. An individual may not drive a school vehicle on any highway in this State unless the individual: (1) Passes an appropriate medical examination BEFORE EMPLOYMENT AND ONCE DURING EACH 2 YEARS OF EMPLOYMENT; and

- 1 (2) For driving a school bus, has been issued a commercial driver's license 2 endorsed school bus.
- 3 (b) Except as provided in subsections (c) and (d) of this section, a driver of a school 4 vehicle may not allow an individual who is not a student or school employee to board or ride 5 on the school vehicle.
- 6 (c) An individual may board and ride on a school vehicle as a school vehicle 7 attendant if the individual:
- 8 (1) (i) Is an employee of the local school system or transportation 9 company that operates the school vehicle;
- 10 (ii) Is otherwise authorized by the local school system to act as a school vehicle attendant for a child on the school vehicle; or
- 12 (iii) Is a nurse, an aide, or any other individual assigned or 13 authorized to work with a student in accordance with the student's individualized 14 education program, 504 Plan under the federal Rehabilitation Act of 1973, or other 15 student–specific written plan; and
- 16 (2) (i) Is in possession of photo identification that identifies the local school system or transportation company that employs the individual as a school vehicle attendant; or
- 19 (ii) Is in possession of photo identification or another document 20 issued by the local school system that authorizes the individual to act as a school vehicle 21 attendant for a child on the school vehicle.
- 22 (d) An individual may board and ride on a school vehicle with the written 23 permission of the local school system.
- 24 (e) With the advice of the State Department of Education, the Administration 25 may adopt regulations concerning the qualifications of school vehicle drivers.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2023.
