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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Speed Monitoring Systems – Penalty for Erroneous Citations**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a court that finds that a citation for an alleged violation  
4 recorded by a speed monitoring system was issued erroneously to require the  
5 person responsible for maintaining the speed monitoring system to pay a  
6 certain penalty to the person to whom the citation was issued; and generally  
7 relating to speed monitoring systems.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Transportation**

16 21–809.

17 **(K) IF A COURT FINDS THAT A CITATION ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION**  
18 **WAS ISSUED ERRONEOUSLY, THE COURT SHALL REQUIRE THE PERSON**  
19 **RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING THE SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM THAT**  
20 **RECORDED THE ALLEGED VIOLATION FOR WHICH THE CITATION WAS ISSUED TO**  
21 **PAY A PENALTY OF \$125 TO THE PERSON WHO WAS ISSUED THE CITATION.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 October 1, 2014.
