## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Anne Arundel County Board of Education – Wireless Telecommunications 3 Towers – Moratorium and Report

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from constructing a wireless telecommunications 5 tower on the grounds of a public school in Anne Arundel County during a certain 6 time period unless certain permits have been issued before a certain date; requiring 7 the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to submit a certain report on the use 8 of public school property for wireless telecommunications towers to the members of 9 the Anne Arundel County delegation to the General Assembly on or before a certain 10 date; requiring the Anne Arundel County Board of Education to publish a certain list 11 and certain information on or before a certain date; specifying the purpose of this 12 Act; providing for the application of this Act; providing for the termination of this 13 Act; and generally relating to wireless telecommunications towers and the use of 14 public school property in Anne Arundel County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That:

- 17 (a) The purpose of this Act is to ensure the appropriate use of property granted, 18 conveyed, devised, or bequeathed for the use of the Anne Arundel County public school 19 system.
- 20 (b) Unless all necessary permits for construction have been issued before the 21 effective date of this Act, a person may not construct a wireless telecommunications tower 22 on the grounds of a public school in Anne Arundel County from the effective date of this Act 23 to June 30, 2016, both inclusive.
- 24 (c) On or before December 31, 2015, the Anne Arundel County Board of Education 25 shall submit a report to the members of the Anne Arundel County delegation to the General

- Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the use of public school property as sites for wireless telecommunications towers, including:
- 3 (1) how the board chooses vendors and contractors for the construction of wireless telecommunications towers on the grounds of public schools;
- 5 (2) how the board evaluates and chooses the locations on the grounds of 6 public schools to be used for the construction of wireless telecommunications towers;
- 7 (3) whether the revenue received in connection with the construction of 8 wireless telecommunications towers will be allocated for use at the school where the 9 wireless telecommunications tower is located or paid into the school system fund; and
- 10 (4) a list of all potential locations on the grounds of public schools in Anne 11 Arundel County that satisfy the zoning and other regulatory criteria applicable to the 12 construction of wireless telecommunications towers, including the following information for 13 each school:
- 14 (i) the name and address of the school;
- 15 (ii) the enrollment by grade, race, and ethnicity; and
- 16 (iii) the number of students eligible for free or reduced–price meals.
- 17 (d) On or before December 31, 2015, the Anne Arundel County Board of Education 18 shall publish the list of potential locations and information specified in subsection (c)(4) of 19 this section on the Web site of the Anne Arundel County public school system.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a presently existing obligation or contract right may not be impaired in any way by this Act.
  - SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2016, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
