2 **Calvert County – Roadside Solicitation of Money or Donations – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from standing in a roadway, median divider, or
4 intersection to solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle in Calvert
5 County; and generally relating to roadside solicitation of money or donations in
6 Calvert County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 21–507.

16 (c) In **CALVERT COUNTY**, Carroll County, Charles County, Harford County, and
17 Washington County, a person may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection
18 to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle.
