A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Board of Education – Common Core Disclosure Act**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Baltimore County Board of Education to submit a
4 report detailing all expenditures made due to the implementation of the
5 Common Core State Standards in Baltimore County to certain entities on or
6 before a certain date; requiring the Board to make a certain report available to
7 the public on the Board's Web site; and generally relating to the implementation
8 of the Common Core State Standards in Baltimore County.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 **5–119.**

18 **ANNUALLY, ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, THE BALTIMORE COUNTY**
19 **BOARD OF EDUCATION SHALL:**

20 **(1) SUBMIT TO THE BALTIMORE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, THE**
21 **BALTIMORE COUNTY COUNCIL, AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE**
22 **STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE MEMBERS OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY**
23 **DELEGATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, A REPORT DETAILING ALL**
24 **EXPENDITURES MADE DUE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE COMMON CORE**

2 COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH:

3 (I) PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND
4 MATERIALS;

5 (II) TEXTBOOKS AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS;

6 (III) TECHNOLOGICAL INFRASTRUCTURE, COMPUTERS, AND
7 SOFTWARE;

8 (IV) ASSESSMENTS DEVELOPED BY THE PARTNERSHIP FOR
9 ASSESSMENT OF READINESS FOR COLLEGE AND CAREERS;

10 (V) TEACHER EVALUATIONS; AND

11 (VI) ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING THE
12 DEVELOPMENT OF POLICIES AND REGULATIONS; AND

13 (2) MAKE EACH REPORT REQUIRED UNDER ITEM (1) OF THIS
14 SECTION AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE BOARD'S WEB SITE.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2014.
