[Assisted] Suicide. 3–101.1. 16 ATTEMPTED SUICIDE IS NOT A CRIME IN THE STATE. 17 (A) 18 THE ACT OF ATTEMPTING TO COMMIT SUICIDE, IN ITSELF, MAY NOT 19 FORM THE BASIS OF A CRIMINAL CHARGE AGAINST THE PERSON WHO ATTEMPTED 20 TO COMMIT SUICIDE.



- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the common law offense of attempted suicide is hereby abrogated and repealed.
