- 5 (B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE FOR A METHOD BY WHICH 6 AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD MAY 7 DESIGNATE UP TO THREE EMERGENCY CONTACTS.
- 8 (C) IF AN APPLICANT DESIGNATES AN EMERGENCY CONTACT, THE
 9 ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAKE A NOTATION OF THIS FACT ON THE APPLICANT'S
 10 DRIVING RECORD OR RECORD OF APPLICATION FOR AN IDENTIFICATION CARD.
 - (D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:
- 12 (1) DEVELOP A DATABASE SYSTEM THAT CONTAINS THE 13 TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF THE APPLICANT'S EMERGENCY CONTACTS; AND
- 14 (2) DEVELOP A SYSTEM FOR ALLOWING A LAW ENFORCEMENT
 15 OFFICER TO ACCESS AN EMERGENCY CONTACT TELEPHONE NUMBER THAT IS
 16 STORED IN THE DATABASE SYSTEM.
- 17 (E) AT THE TIME THE APPLICANT DESIGNATES AN EMERGENCY 18 CONTACT, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL NOTIFY THE APPLICANT THAT:
- 19 (1) THE DESIGNATION AUTHORIZES A LAW ENFORCEMENT 20 OFFICER TO ACCESS THE APPLICANT'S EMERGENCY CONTACT TELEPHONE 21 NUMBERS; AND
- 22 **(2)** THE DESIGNATION CAN BE REMOVED ONLY AS PROVIDED BY 23 THE ADMINISTRATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
