A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Commission to Study the Impact of the Common Core State Standards in Harford County

- FOR the purpose of establishing the Commission to Study the Impact of the Common 4 5 Core State Standards in Harford County; providing for the composition, chair, 6 and staffing of the Commission; prohibiting a member of the Commission from 7 receiving certain compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain 8 expenses; requiring the Commission to study a certain impact, hold certain 9 public meetings, evaluate certain concerns, and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Commission to report its findings and 10 recommendations to certain persons on or before a certain date; providing for 11 12the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Commission to Study the Impact of the Common Core State Standards in Harford County. 13
- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That:
- 16 (a) There is a Commission to Study the Impact of the Common Core State Standards in Harford County.
 - (b) The Commission consists of the following members:
- 19 (1) the Chair of the Harford County Senators, or the Chair's designee;
- 20 (2) the Chair of the Harford County House Delegation, or the Chair's 21 designee;
- 22 (3) one representative of the Harford County Council of Parent 23 Teacher Association, appointed by the Council;
