1 AN ACT concerning 2 Business Regulation - Cigarette, Other Tobacco Product, and Electronic 3 Smoking Device Retailers - Nicotine Replacement Therapy Products 4 (Make Quitting Convenient Act) 5 FOR the purpose of requiring licensees that sell cigarettes, other tobacco products, or 6 electronic smoking devices at retail to keep in stock and offer for sale at retail at 7 least one kind of nicotine replacement therapy product and to post certain signs; and 8 generally relating to the retail sale of nicotine replacement therapy products. 9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, 10 Article – Business Regulation 11 Section 16–201(a), (d), and (k), 16.5–101(a), (f), (j), and (l), and 16.7–101(a), (c), and 12 (e) 13 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) 14 15 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 16 Article – Business Regulation 17 Section 16–209, 16.5–214.1, and 16.7–204.1 18 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) 19 20 BY adding to 21Article – Business Regulation 22 Section 16–209.1, 16.5–214.2, and 16.7–204.2 23 Annotated Code of Maryland 24(2015 Replacement Volume and 2023 Supplement) 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:


