## 2 Maryland Longitudinal Data System – Transfer of Student Data – Modifications

3 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law relating to the collection of 4 identifying information on certificates and licenses; requiring certain licensing  $\mathbf{5}$ authorities to make certain efforts to comply with certain data requirements, comply 6 with a certain implementation schedule of the Maryland Longitudinal Data System, 7 and transfer student data in accordance with a certain plan; requiring certain industry certifiers to comply with certain data requirements, comply with a certain 8 9 implementation schedule of the Maryland Longitudinal Data System, and transfer 10 student data in accordance with a certain plan; altering the membership of the 11 Governing Board of the Maryland Longitudinal Data System Center; defining 12certain terms; altering certain definitions; and generally relating to the transfer of 13student data and the Maryland Longitudinal Data System.
