A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Department of Education – Personal Financial Literacy State**
3 **Curriculum**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain county boards of education to make certain
5 certifications regarding a certain curriculum on or before a certain date each
6 year; requiring the State Department of Education to develop a process to
7 monitor certain implementation of a certain curriculum; requiring the
8 Department to report certain information to the Governor and General
9 Assembly on or before a certain date each year; and generally relating to the
10 monitoring and implementation of the Personal Financial Literacy State
11 Curriculum.

15 Annotated Code of Maryland

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Education**

20 **4–111.1.**

21 **(A) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, EACH COUNTY**
22 **SUPERINTENDENT SHALL CERTIFY TO THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT THAT THE**
23 **PERSONAL FINANCIAL LITERACY STATE CURRICULUM IS BEING TAUGHT IN**
24 **THE COUNTY.**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A PROCESS TO MONITOR**
2 **IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CURRICULUM AS CERTIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)**
3 **OF THIS SECTION.**

4 **(C) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT**
5 **SHALL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE**
6 **GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, REGARDING THE**
7 **MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CURRICULUM.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2010.
