- 17 (a) (1) The Board of Trustees of Chesapeake College consists of two
  18 members from each county that supports Chesapeake College who shall be appointed
  19 by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the House of Delegates, FROM A LIST
  20 OF AT LEAST THREE QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNOR
- 21 BY EACH COUNTY THAT SUPPORTS CHESAPEAKE COLLEGE.
- 22 (2) The county superintendents of schools in the region are not ex 23 officio members.

### **HOUSE BILL 855**

1 (b) (1) The term of a member is 5 years and begins on July 1. (i) 2 (ii) A member continues to serve until a successor is appointed 3 and qualifies. 4 (2)Subject to subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, a member (i) appointed to begin a full term on or after July 1, 2006, may not serve for more than 5 6 three 5-year full terms. 7 (ii) A term of a member that began before July 1, 2006, does not 8 count toward the term limit established in subparagraph (i) of this paragraph. Each member of the Board: 9 (c) 10 (1) Serves without compensation; and 11 **(2)** Is entitled to reimbursement for expenses in accordance with applicable travel regulations. 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13
