BY adding to Article – Real Property Section 8–119 Annotated Code of Maryland (2015 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Real Property 8-119. - 25 MANAGEMENT COMPANY IS NOT OPEN FOR CONDUCTING BUSINESS ON THE SITE OF

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
