## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Courts and Judicial Proceedings – Testimony by Convicted Perjurer**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing an exception to a certain prohibition on a person  
4 convicted of perjury testifying in a proceeding for a person whose testimony  
5 relates to events in which the person is an alleged victim; and generally relating  
6 to testimony by a convicted perjurer.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 9–104.

16 **(A) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A**  
17 **person convicted of perjury may not testify.**

18 **(B) A PERSON CONVICTED OF PERJURY MAY TESTIFY IF THE**  
19 **TESTIMONY RELATES TO EVENTS IN WHICH THE PERSON IS AN ALLEGED VICTIM.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 2012.
