1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Senator William H. Amoss Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance Funds – Property**
3 **Acquisition and Construction of Facilities**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing certain requirements regarding the location of land that may
5 be acquired by the State under the Senator William H. Amoss Fire, Rescue, and
6 Ambulance Fund; authorizing the use of the Fund for certain construction; and
7 generally relating to the Senator William H. Amoss Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance
8 Fund.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Public Safety**

2 (a) There is a Senator William H. Amoss Fire, Rescue, and Ambulance Fund.

3 (b) The purposes of the Fund are to promote:

4 (1) the delivery of effective and high quality fire protection, rescue, and
5 ambulance services in the State;

6 (2) increased financial support for fire, rescue, and ambulance companies
7 by counties; and

8 (3) the continued financial viability of volunteer fire, rescue, and
9 ambulance companies given the greatly increased costs of equipment.

10 (f) (1) State money provided under this section may only be used to:

11 (i) acquire or rehabilitate fire or rescue equipment, including
12 ambulances;

13 (ii) acquire or rehabilitate capital equipment used in connection with
14 fire or rescue equipment;

15 (iii) rehabilitate facilities used primarily to house fire fighting
16 equipment, ambulances, and rescue vehicles;

17 (iv) install life safety and fire protection systems at a fire, a rescue,
18 or an ambulance facility;

19 (v) acquire land [that is adjacent to an existing fire, rescue, or
20 ambulance facility] for the purpose of [rehabilitating that] **REHABILITATION OR**
21 **CONSTRUCTION OF A FIRE, A RESCUE, OR AN AMBULANCE** facility;

22 (vi) acquire wireless telecommunications devices, computers, and
23 related computer equipment if used exclusively for fire protection, rescue, and ambulance
24 services; and

25 (vii) acquire machinery and equipment if used exclusively for fire
26 protection, rescue, and ambulance services.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 2022.
