- 4 (iii) because of the person's position or occupation, exercises 5 supervision over a minor who attends the school; and
- 6 (2) includes a principal, vice principal, teacher, coach, [or] school 7 counselor, OR A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER, POLICE OFFICER, OR OTHER SECURITY 8 OFFICER at a public or private preschool, elementary school, or secondary school.
- 9 (c) (1) Except as provided in § 3–307(a)(4) of this subtitle or subsection (b)(2) of this section, a person in a position of authority may not engage in a sexual act or sexual contact with a minor who, at the time of the sexual act or sexual contact, is a student enrolled at a school where the person in a position of authority is employed.
 - (2) Except as provided in § 3–307(a)(5) of this subtitle or subsection (b)(3) of this section, a person in a position of authority may not engage in vaginal intercourse with a minor who, at the time of the vaginal intercourse, is a student enrolled at a school where the person in a position of authority is employed.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2022.
