19	WHEREAS, Maryland has a long history of environmental stewardship and a
20	commitment to protecting the natural beauty and resources of the State; and
21	WHEREAS, Climate change poses a significant threat to our environment, economy
22	and public health; and

WHEREAS, Maryland is uniquely positioned to lead in climate change education as

a state that possesses diverse ecosystems, vulnerable coastal areas, and the Chesapeake

Bay, all of which are directly impacted by climate pollution; and



- WHEREAS, Education plays a vital role in raising awareness about climate change and its causes, consequences, and solutions; and
- WHEREAS, Institutions of higher education, research organizations, and environmental and advocacy groups in the State are at the forefront of climate change research and education and are the State's partners in this critical effort; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Maryland is dedicated to fostering a culture of sustainability and environmental responsibility among its residents, businesses, and institutions; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Maryland leads the nation in its efforts to reduce greenhouse gas 9 emissions that cause climate pollution; now, therefore,
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 7–601 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–602.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 15 Article – General Provisions

- 16 **7–601.**
- 17 (A) THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM THE FIRST WEEK OF 18 APRIL AS MARYLAND CLIMATE EDUCATION WEEK.
- 19 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE RESIDENTS OF ALL AGES TO:
- 20 (1) PARTICIPATE IN EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND INITIATIVES 21 THAT PROMOTE AN AWARENESS OF CLIMATE CHANGE; AND
- 22 (2) TAKE ACTION TOWARD THE STATE'S CLIMATE COMMITMENTS.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
