A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Transportation – Heads of Business Units – Appointment and**
3 **Senate Confirmation**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain heads of business units in the Department of
5 Transportation be appointed by the Secretary of Transportation with the approval
6 of the Governor; requiring that the heads of business units in the Department be
7 appointed with the advice and consent of the Senate; and generally relating to the
8 heads of business units in the Department of Transportation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

4–201.

There is a Maryland Transportation Authority.

4–203.

(a) **(1) THE HEAD OF THE AUTHORITY IS THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

(2) The Authority is entitled to the staff provided in the State budget.

5–202.

There is a Maryland Aviation Administration in the Department.

5–202.1.

(a) The head of the Administration is the Executive Director, **WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

6–202.

There is a Maryland Port Administration.

6–203.

(a) The head of the Administration is the Executive Director, **WHO SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

7–201.

There is a Maryland Transit Administration in the Department.

7–202.

(a) The head of the Administration is the Maryland Transit Administrator, who

1 shall be appointed by the Secretary with the approval of the Governor **AND THE ADVICE**
2 **AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

3 8–201.

4 There is a State Highway Administration in the Department.

5 8–202.

6 (a) The head of the Administration is the State Highway Administrator, who shall
7 be appointed by the Secretary with the approval of the Governor **AND THE ADVICE AND**
8 **CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

9 12–101.

10 There is a Motor Vehicle Administration in the Department.

11 12–102.

12 (a) The head of the Administration is the Motor Vehicle Administrator, who shall
13 be appointed by the Secretary with the approval of the Governor **AND THE ADVICE AND**
14 **CONSENT OF THE SENATE.**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2020.
