A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County Board of Education – Selection of Members – Straw**
3 **Ballot**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that a question be placed on the ballot in Anne Arundel
5 County at the November general election of 2014 to determine the sense of the
6 voters of the County on the issue of changing the method of selecting members
7 of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education; providing for the carrying out
8 of the straw ballot; and generally relating to the holding of a straw ballot in
9 Anne Arundel County.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
11 MARYLAND, That under the provisions of the Election Law Article, the Anne Arundel
12 County Board of Elections, in consultation with the State Board of Elections, shall
13 prepare and include on the ballot for the November general election of 2014 the
14 following question:

15 “Do you favor changing the method of selection of the members of the Anne
16 Arundel County Board of Education from appointment by the Governor (subject to
17 each member’s approval or rejection or retention or removal by the voters of the
18 County at a subsequent election) to have instead a direct election by the voters of
19 Anne Arundel County?”

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Anne Arundel
21 County Board of Elections and the County Council of Anne Arundel County shall do
22 those things necessary and proper to place this question on the ballot prepared for the
23 November general election of 2014, so that each participating voter in the County may
24 have the opportunity to cast a vote on the question. The question shall be proposed,
25 presented, tallied, and reported in general accordance with the provisions of the
26 Election Law Article. The vote on this question is advisory only.

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 July 1, 2013.
