A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Sexual Supplement Safety Act**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, except on a valid prescription of a certain authorized
4 prescriber, a person from marketing, selling, offering for sale, or distributing a
5 certain aphrodisiac drug product; providing civil penalties for a violation of this
6 Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to aphrodisiac drug
7 products.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Health – General**

16 **24–304.**

17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “APHRODISIAC DRUG PRODUCT” MEANS A DRUG,
18 MEDICINE, CHEMICAL, PREPARATION, OR FORMULA THAT BEARS LABELING
19 CLAIMS THAT IT WILL AROUSE OR INCREASE SEXUAL DESIRE OR THAT IT WILL
20 IMPROVE SEXUAL PERFORMANCE.

21 (B) EXCEPT ON A VALID PRESCRIPTION OF AN AUTHORIZED
22 PRESCRIBER AS DEFINED IN § 12–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE,
23 A PERSON MAY NOT MARKET, SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE AN
24 APHRODISIAC DRUG PRODUCT.

1 **(C) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL**
2 **PENALTY OF:**

3 **(1) \$5,000 FOR A FIRST VIOLATION; AND**

4 **(2) \$10,000 FOR A SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2010.
