24	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
25	That Section(s) 2.5–103 through 2.5–108 of Article – Business Regulation of the Annotated

Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 2.5–104 through 2.5–109, respectively.

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SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article – Business Regulation

4 2.5–101.

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- 5 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 6 (b) (1) "License" means any grant of authority to an individual to practice an 7 occupation or profession.
- 8 (2) "License" includes a certificate, permit, or registration.
- 9 (e) "Unit" means a unit in the Department that is authorized to issue a license.
- 10 (f) "Veteran" means a former service member who was discharged from active 11 duty under circumstances other than dishonorable before the date on which the application 12 for a license is submitted.
- 13 **2.5–103.**
- 14 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A UNIT THAT ESTABLISHES A PROCESS UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 16 (B) EACH UNIT MAY ESTABLISH A PROCESS TO INCLUDE A NOTATION INDICATING VETERAN STATUS ON A LICENSE AND TO ASSIST IN DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE AND FEDERAL VETERANS' BENEFITS.
- 19 (C) (1) AN APPLICATION FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR RENEWAL LICENSE 20 ISSUED BY A UNIT SHALL ALLOW THE APPLICANT TO:
- 21 (I) REQUEST THAT A NOTATION OF THE APPLICANT'S VETERAN 22 STATUS BE INCLUDED ON THE LICENSE; AND
- 23 (II) PROVIDE AFFIRMATIVE CONSENT TO BEING CONTACTED BY 24 APPROPRIATE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES REGARDING THE APPLICANT'S 25 ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE OR FEDERAL VETERANS' BENEFITS.
- 26 (2) AN APPLICANT FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR A RENEWAL LICENSE
  27 SHALL SUBMIT TO THE UNIT ONE OF THE FOLLOWING AS CERTIFICATION OF
  28 VETERAN STATUS:

- 1 (I) A CERTIFICATION OF VETERAN STATUS OBTAINED FROM 2 THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AND MILITARY FAMILIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 3 9–905 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE;
- 4 (II) A FEDERAL CERTIFICATE OF RELEASE OR DISCHARGE 5 FROM ACTIVE DUTY (DD FORM 214); OR
- 6 (III) ANY OTHER DOCUMENTATION ACCEPTABLE TO THE UNIT.
- 7 (D) IF AN APPLICANT FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR A RENEWAL LICENSE 8 SUBMITS THE DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(2) OF THIS 9 SECTION, THE UNIT SHALL INCLUDE A NOTATION OF VETERAN STATUS ON THE 10 LICENSE.
- 11 (E) IN ACCORDANCE WITH §§ 4–304 THROUGH 4–325 OF THE GENERAL PROVISIONS ARTICLE AND ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAW, AND ON REQUEST BY AN EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY, A UNIT SHALL ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMIT TO THE
- 14 EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCY APPROPRIATE INFORMATION ABOUT EACH
- 15 APPLICANT FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR A RENEWAL LICENSE WHO CONSENTS TO
- 15 APPLICANT FOR AN INITIAL LICENSE OR A RENEWAL LICENSE WHO CONSENTS TO
- 16 BEING CONTACTED UNDER SUBSECTION (C)(1) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2025.
