20 21	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 1 (a) (1) The Commission shall impose an assessment of 6.5%, payable to 2 the Subsequent Injury Fund, on:
- 3 (i) each award against an employer or its insurer for 4 permanent disability or death, including awards for disfigurement and mutilation;
- 5 (ii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, each 6 amount payable by an employer or its insurer under a settlement agreement approved 7 by the Commission; and
- 8 (iii) each amount payable under item (i) or (ii) of this paragraph 9 by the Property and Casualty Guaranty Corporation on behalf of an insolvent insurer.
- 10 (3) (I) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2014, AND ON OR BEFORE JULY
 11 1 EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, AN EMPLOYER OR ITS INSURER THAT IS LIABLE FOR
 12 PAYMENT OF AN ASSESSMENT IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL NOTIFY
 13 THE SUBSEQUENT INJURY FUND OF THE CURRENT BILLING ADDRESS TO WHICH
 14 NOTICES OF PAYMENT SHALL BE SENT.
- 15 (II) AN EMPLOYER OR ITS INSURER THAT HAS PROVIDED
 16 NOTICE UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL NOTIFY THE
 17 SUBSEQUENT INJURY FUND OF ANY CHANGE OF BILLING ADDRESS WITHIN 30
 18 DAYS OF THE CHANGE OF ADDRESS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2014.
