A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Raffles**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of County Commissioners for Frederick
4 County to determine the number of raffles that certain organizations in
5 Frederick County may conduct in a calendar year; and generally relating to
6 raffles in Frederick County.

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

24 **Article – Criminal Law**

25 13–1304.

1 (a) Before an organization listed in subsection (b) of this section may conduct
2 a gaming event, the organization shall obtain a permit from the county agency that
3 the county commissioners designate.

4 (b) An organization may conduct a gaming event for its own benefit if the
5 organization is:

6 (1) a bona fide:

7 (i) religious organization;

8 (ii) fraternal organization;

9 (iii) civic organization;

10 (iv) war veterans' organization;

11 (v) hospital;

12 (vi) amateur athletic organization;

13 (vii) patriotic organization;

14 (viii) educational organization; or

15 (ix) charitable organization;

16 (2) a Frederick County volunteer:

17 (i) fire company;

18 (ii) rescue company; or

19 (iii) ambulance company; or

20 (3) an auxiliary for a Frederick County volunteer:

21 (i) fire company;

22 (ii) rescue company; or

23 (iii) ambulance company.

24 (f) (2) During each calendar year, the holder of a gaming event, including
25 a raffle for which the prize drawings are held on a single day, may not hold or receive
26 the proceeds from[:

1 (i)] more than one gaming event in which the major prize has a
2 value of more than \$5,000[; and

3 (ii) more than five raffles for which the prize drawings are held
4 on a single day and in which the major prize has a value of \$5,000 or less].

5 **(4) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MAY DETERMINE THE**
6 **NUMBER OF RAFFLES THAT AN ORGANIZATION MAY CONDUCT IN 1 CALENDAR**
7 **YEAR.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 2011.
