15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 20 21	(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the Department may develop and implement an electronic system for the sale and issuance of licenses, permits, and registrations and the recording and releasing of security interests.

7 8	[(iii)] (IV) Any other money from any other source accepted for the benefit of the Fund.
9 10 11 12	(7) The Fund may be used only for donated recreational hunting or fishing licenses or stamps for use by Gold Star recipients, disabled veterans, disabled members of the armed forces of the United States, or permanently disabled persons who require the use of a wheelchair.
13 14	(8) (i) The State Treasurer shall invest the money of the Fund in the same manner as other State money may be invested.
15 16	(ii) Any interest earnings of the Fund shall be credited to the General Fund of the State.
17 18	(9) Expenditures from the Fund may be made only in accordance with the State budget.
19 20 21 22 23	(10) Money expended from the Fund for donated recreational licenses or stamps is supplemental to and is not intended to take the place of funding that otherwise would be appropriated for recreational licenses or stamps for use by Gold Star recipients, disabled veterans, disabled members of the armed forces of the United States, or permanently disabled persons who require the use of a wheelchair.
24 25 26 27 28	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2018. It shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 4 of Chapter 424 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2016. If that termination provision takes effect, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.
