4 FOR the purpose of requiring licensed physicians to maintain certain minimum amounts 5 of professional liability insurance or attest to certain coverage as a condition of 6 licensure and comply with certain regulations; requiring a licensed physician to 7 notify the State Board of Physicians of the cancellation of the insurance or coverage 8 within a certain time period; requiring a physician to provide the Board with certain 9 verification or documentation on a certain application and at any other time on request of the Board; authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; authorizing 10 11 the Board to take certain actions if verification or other documentation of insurance 12 or coverage is not provided as required by certain provisions of this Act; authorizing 13 the Board to conduct certain audits for certain purposes; providing for the construction of certain provisions of this Act; making conforming changes; and 14 15 generally relating to physicians and liability coverage.
