- 1 AGENCY SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PORTION OF THE COST OF COVERED
- 2 SERVICES PROVIDED TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS AND ENROLLEES IN THE
- 3 MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM THAT IS NOT REIMBURSED BY THE
- 4 FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

- 6 October 1, 2023.
