16 17 18 19 20	(b) (1) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE General Assembly shall appropriate the remaining funds not appropriated under subsection (a) of this section to assist local governing bodies in acquisition and development of land for recreation and open space purposes, including the provision of public access to the land.
21 22	(2) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, funds appropriated under paragraph (1) of this subsection for development of land for recreation

and open space purposes may be used for indoor or outdoor recreation and open space

purposes, including the construction of indoor or outdoor recreational facilities such as

- 4 (i) If the facility is 7,500 square feet or greater, meet or exceed the 5 current version of the U.S. Green Building Council's LEED Green Building Rating System 6 Silver rating, however, the facility is not required to be certified through the LEED 7 certification process; and
- 8 (ii) Incorporate, to the maximum extent practicable, the 9 nonstructural site design practices in the Maryland Stormwater Design Manual, 10 incorporated by reference in COMAR 26.17.02.
- 11 (4) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.
- 12 (II) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, FUNDS
 13 APPROPRIATED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY BE USED TO
 14 ASSIST THE COUNTY IN ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT OF LAND FOR
 15 EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2018.
