- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND.
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Election Law
- 20 11–302.
- 21 (a) Following an election, each local board shall meet at its designated counting
- 22 center to canvass the absentee ballots cast in that election in accordance with the
- 23 regulations and guidelines established by the State Board.

- 1 (E) AT THE END OF EACH DAY OF CANVASSING, A LOCAL BOARD SHALL PREPARE AND RELEASE A REPORT OF THE UNOFFICIAL RESULTS OF THE ABSENTEE
- 3 BALLOT VOTE TABULATION.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 2019.
