A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2009 – Prince George’s County**
3 **– Whitemarsh Turf Field**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2009
5 to change the name of a certain grantee to the Mayor and City Council of the
6 City of Bowie; extending the deadline for the grantee to present evidence that a
7 matching fund will be provided; requiring that the Board of Public Works
8 expend or encumber the proceeds of the loan by June 1, 2013; and generally
9 relating to amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2009.

10 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
11 Chapter 485 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2009
12 Section 1(3) Item ZA03(BJ)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Chapter 485 of the Acts of 2009**

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That:

18 (3) ZA03 LOCAL SENATE INITIATIVES

19 (BJ) Whitemarsh Turf Field. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of
20 (i) \$25,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided,
21 to the [Board of Directors of the Bowie Boys and Girls Club,
22 Inc.] **MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE**
23 for the construction of the Whitemarsh Turf Field, located in
24 Bowie. Notwithstanding Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching
25 fund may consist of in kind contributions, **AND THE**

1 GRANTEE HAS UNTIL **JUNE 1, 2013**, TO PRESENT
 2 EVIDENCE THAT A MATCHING FUND WILL BE PROVIDED.
 3 NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 1(7) OF THIS ACT, THE
 4 PROCEEDS OF THE LOAN MUST BE EXPENDED OR
 5 ENCUMBERED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR
 6 THE PURPOSES PROVIDED IN THIS ACT NO LATER THAN
 7 **JUNE 1, 2013** (Prince George’s County) 25,000

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 9 June 1, 2011.
