A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Barbers – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Barbers in accordance with the provisions
4 of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date
5 the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the
6 Board; and generally relating to the State Board of Barbers.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

20 4–201.

21 There is a State Board of Barbers in the Department.
