1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Lottery Tickets – Prohibited Acts – Delivery Service**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person or governmental unit from selling or purchasing
4 a State lottery ticket on behalf of certain individuals and delivering or transmitting
5 the ticket in a certain manner as part of a for-profit business delivery service; and
6 generally relating to the sale and purchase of State lottery tickets.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – State Government**

15 9–124.

16 (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a person or governmental unit
17 may not:

2 (i) a State lottery ticket or share at any price other than the price
3 that the regulations of the Agency set; [or]

4 (ii) the prize validated for payment by the Agency; OR

5 (III) A STATE LOTTERY TICKET ON BEHALF OF AN INDIVIDUAL
6 LOCATED WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE STATE AND DELIVER OR TRANSMIT THE TICKET
7 OR AN ELECTRONIC IMAGE OF THE TICKET TO AN INDIVIDUAL AS A FOR-PROFIT
8 BUSINESS DELIVERY SERVICE;

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2017.
