AN ACT concerning

Office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation - Sunset Extension

FOR the purpose of continuing the office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation; and generally relating to the office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article – Financial Institutions Section 2–401

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Financial Institutions

2-401.

Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, the provisions of this article that create the office of the Commissioner of Financial Regulation or relate to the powers and duties of the Commissioner and any regulations adopted under these provisions shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2022] **2032**.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2021.
