A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes Against Animals – Interference With Livestock**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the scope of a certain prohibition against interfering with,
4 injuring, tampering with, or destroying a horse used for a certain purpose to prohibit
5 a person from interfering with, injuring, tampering with, or destroying livestock used
6 for a certain purpose or for any other lawful activity; defining a certain term; and
7 generally relating to crimes against animals.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Agriculture**

21 3–301.

22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

23 (b) “Livestock” means cattle, swine, sheep, horses, asses, mules, or goats
24 notwithstanding any other provision of this article.

Article – Criminal Law

10–620.

(a) IN THIS SECTION, “LIVESTOCK” HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 3–301 OF THE AGRICULTURE ARTICLE.

(B) A person may not:

(1) willfully and maliciously interfere with, injure, destroy, or tamper with [a horse] LIVESTOCK used for:

(I) racing or breeding [or for];

(II) a competitive exhibition of skill, breed, or stamina; OR

(III) ANY OTHER LAWFUL ACTIVITY;

(2) willfully start, instigate, engage in, or further an act that interferes with, injures, destroys, or tampers with [a horse] LIVESTOCK used for:

(I) racing or breeding [or for];

(II) a competitive exhibition of skill, breed, or stamina; OR

(III) ANY OTHER LAWFUL ACTIVITY; or

(3) commit an act that tends to interfere with, injure, destroy, or tamper with [a horse] LIVESTOCK used for:

(I) racing or breeding [or for];

(II) a competitive exhibition of skill, breed, or stamina; OR

(III) ANY OTHER LAWFUL ACTIVITY.

[(b)] (C) A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony and on conviction is subject to imprisonment of not less than 1 year and not exceeding 3 years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
