1 2	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5	(t) (1) The annual salary of the Sheriff of St. Mary's County shall be:
6	(i) \$100,000 for the calendar year 2015;
7	(ii) \$102,000 for the calendar year 2016;

- 5 (4) [\$51,515] **\$63,000** for calendar year 2018.
- 6 (b) The County Treasurer of St. Mary's County shall devote full time to the duties 7 of office.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary 9 10 or compensation of the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the County Treasurer of St. Mary's 11 County, or the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County while serving in a term of office 12 beginning before the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the 13 salary or compensation of the Sheriff of St. Mary's County, the County Treasurer of St. Mary's County, and the State's Attorney for St. Mary's County shall take effect at the 14 beginning of the next following term of office. This limitation does not apply to an individual 15 appointed or elected after the effective date of this Act to fill out an unexpired term. 16
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2017.
