# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (B) A CANDIDATE MAY SEEK AN IMMEDIATE INJUNCTION AGAINST ANY 18 VIOLATION OF § 13–309(A)(3) OR (6) OF THIS TITLE BY THE CAMPAIGN FINANCE 19 ENTITY SUPPORTING THE CANDIDACY OF ANY CANDIDATE FOR THE SAME OFFICE.
