A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City – Alcoholic Beverages – 45th Alcoholic Beverages District –**
3 **Licenses**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Baltimore City to
5 issue a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license in a certain area of the 45th alcoholic
6 beverages district in Baltimore City under certain circumstances; altering a
7 geographic boundary in the 45th district within which the holder of a Class A or
8 Class B–D–7 beer, wine, and liquor license must operate in accordance with specified
9 hours; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Baltimore City.

25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
26 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis

12–102.

This title applies only in Baltimore City.

12–1603.

(a) The alcoholic beverages districts described in this section at all times are coterminous with the legislative districts in the Legislative Districting Plan of 2022.

(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, the Board may not issue a new license in:

(1) the 40th alcoholic beverages district;

(2) the 41st alcoholic beverages district;

(3) the 43rd alcoholic beverages district;

(4) the 44th alcoholic beverages district; and

(5) the 45th alcoholic beverages district.

(c) The Board may issue:

(2) **SUBJECT TO ITEM (19) OF THIS SUBSECTION**, a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license in the 45th alcoholic beverages district;

(17) a Class A–7 beer, wine, and liquor license in the 1200 block of West North Avenue in the 40th alcoholic beverages district, if:

(i) the applicant executes a memorandum of understanding with the Penn North Community Association;

(ii) alcoholic beverages are sold only as part of a gift basket or floral arrangement; and

(iii) the applicant does not hold or apply for a Class BWLT beer, wine, and liquor (on–premises) tasting license; [and]

(18) a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license for a restaurant on the even side of the 400 block of West 29th Street in the 40th alcoholic beverages district if:

(i) the applicant executes a memorandum of understanding with the Greater Remington Improvement Association; and

1 (ii) the Board waives a minimum seating requirement under item
2 (1)(ii)2 of this subsection; AND

3 (19) A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE IN THE 400 BLOCK
4 OF EAST OLIVER STREET IN THE 45TH ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES DISTRICT, ONLY IF:

5 (I) THE APPLICANT DOES NOT CONVERT THE LICENSE TO A
6 DIFFERENT LICENSE CLASS;

7 (II) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SERVED OUTDOORS ONLY TO
8 PATRONS SEATED AT TABLES OR STANDING IN A COURTYARD AREA;

9 (III) THE APPLICANT DOES NOT ALLOW THE OFF-PREMISES SALE
10 OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES;

11 (IV) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES SALES BEGIN NOT EARLIER THAN
12 10 A.M.; AND

13 (V) THE APPLICANT EXECUTES A MEMORANDUM OF
14 UNDERSTANDING WITH THE GREENMOUNT WEST COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION.

15 12-2004.

16 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, a holder of a Class A beer,
17 wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine, and liquor:

18 (i) on Monday through Saturday:

19 1. from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the area specified in the Park
20 Heights Master Plan adopted by the City in 2006; [and]

21 2. FROM 9 A.M. TO 10 P.M. IN AN AREA BOUNDED AS
22 FOLLOWS: FROM THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND ANNTANA AVENUE,
23 SOUTHWEST ON BELAIR ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND
24 FRANKFORD AVENUE, SOUTHEAST ON FRANKFORD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION
25 OF FRANKFORD AVENUE AND SIPPLE AVENUE, WEST ON SIPPLE AVENUE TO THE
26 INTERSECTION OF SIPPLE AVENUE AND CRENSHAW AVENUE, SOUTHEAST ON
27 CRENSHAW AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF CRENSHAW AVENUE AND
28 GOODNOW ROAD, SOUTHEAST ON GOODNOW ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF
29 GOODNOW ROAD AND SINCLAIR LANE, NORTHEAST ON SINCLAIR LANE TO THE
30 INTERSECTION OF SINCLAIR LANE AND RADECKE AVENUE, WEST ON RADECKE
31 AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF RADECKE AVENUE AND ANNTANA AVENUE,
32 THEN NORTH ON ANNTANA AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF ANNTANA AVENUE
33 AND BELAIR ROAD; AND

1 **3.** from 6 a.m. to midnight in all other locations in the City;
2 and

3 (ii) on the Sundays that fall between Thanksgiving Day and New
4 Year's Day, from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., if, on or before September 30 of that year, the license
5 holder has paid a supplementary license fee of \$120 for each Sunday the privilege is to be
6 exercised.

7 (2) In addition to the privileges specified under paragraph (1)(ii) of this
8 subsection, the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor for off-premises consumption
9 on two additional Sundays during the calendar year if the holder pays a license fee of \$120
10 at least 2 weeks before each time the privilege is exercised.

11 (c) A holder of a Class B-D-7 beer, wine, and liquor license may sell beer, wine,
12 and liquor:

13 (1) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. in the area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,
14 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue;

15 (2) from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. along the south side of Frederick Avenue between
16 South Augusta Avenue and South Loudon Avenue;

17 (3) from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in the area specified in the Park Heights Master
18 Plan adopted by the City in 2006; [and]

19 (4) from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. in an area bounded as follows: from the
20 intersection of East North Avenue and Harford Avenue, southwest on Harford Avenue to
21 the intersection of Harford Avenue and North Central Avenue, south on North Central
22 Avenue to the intersection with East Monument Street, east on East Monument Street to
23 the intersection of East Monument Street and North Wolfe Street, south on North Wolfe
24 Street to the intersection of North Wolfe Street and McElderry Street, east on McElderry
25 Street to the intersection of McElderry Street and North Collington Avenue, south on North
26 Collington Avenue to the intersection of North Collington Avenue and East Fayette Street,
27 east on East Fayette Street to the intersection of East Fayette Street and North Lakewood
28 Avenue, north on North Lakewood Avenue to the intersection of North Lakewood Avenue
29 and East Monument Street, west on East Monument Street to the intersection of East
30 Monument Street and North Luzerne Avenue, north on North Luzerne Avenue to the
31 intersection of North Luzerne Avenue and East Federal Street, west on East Federal Street
32 to the intersection of East Federal Street and North Rose Street, north on North Rose Street
33 to the intersection of North Rose Street and East North Avenue, then west on East North
34 Avenue to the intersection of East North Avenue and Harford Avenue; [and]

35 (5) **FROM 9 A.M. TO 10 P.M. IN AN AREA BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS: FROM**
36 **THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND ANNTANA AVENUE, SOUTHWEST ON**
37 **BELAIR ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND FRANKFORD AVENUE,**

1 SOUTHEAST ON FRANKFORD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF FRANKFORD
2 AVENUE AND SIPPLE AVENUE, WEST ON SIPPLE AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF
3 SIPPLE AVENUE AND CRENSHAW AVENUE, SOUTHEAST ON CRENSHAW AVENUE TO
4 THE INTERSECTION OF CRENSHAW AVENUE AND GOODNOW ROAD, SOUTHEAST ON
5 GOODNOW ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF GOODNOW ROAD AND SINCLAIR LANE,
6 NORTHEAST ON SINCLAIR LANE TO THE INTERSECTION OF SINCLAIR LANE AND
7 RADECKE AVENUE, WEST ON RADECKE AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF
8 RADECKE AVENUE AND ANNTANA AVENUE, THEN NORTH ON ANNTANA AVENUE TO
9 THE INTERSECTION OF ANNTANA AVENUE AND BELAIR ROAD; AND

10 (6) from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day in all other locations in the City.

12 (c) (1) This subsection does not apply to:

13 (i) a Class B beer and light wine license;

14 (ii) a Class B beer, wine, and liquor license;

15 (iii) a Class B-D-7 beer, wine, and liquor license;

16 (iv) a Class C beer and light wine license; and

17 (v) a Class C beer, wine, and liquor license.

18 (2) For a license holder in an area bounded by Liberty Heights Avenue,
19 Northern Parkway, Druid Park Drive, and Wabash Avenue, the hours of sale:

20 (i) may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after 10 p.m.; and

21 (ii) may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before
22 10 p.m.

23 (3) For a license holder in an area bounded as follows: from the intersection
24 of East North Avenue and Harford Avenue, southwest on Harford Avenue to the
25 intersection of Harford Avenue and North Central Avenue, south on North Central Avenue
26 to the intersection with East Monument Street, east on East Monument Street to the
27 intersection of East Monument Street and North Wolfe Street, south on North Wolfe Street
28 to the intersection of North Wolfe Street and McElderry Street, east on McElderry Street
29 to the intersection of McElderry Street and North Collington Avenue, south on North
30 Collington Avenue to the intersection of North Collington Avenue and East Fayette Street,
31 east on East Fayette Street to the intersection of East Fayette Street and North Lakewood
32 Avenue, north on North Lakewood Avenue to the intersection of North Lakewood Avenue
33 and East Monument Street, west on East Monument Street to the intersection of East
34 Monument Street and North Luzerne Avenue, north on North Luzerne Avenue to the

1 intersection of North Luzerne Avenue and East Federal Street, west on East Federal Street
2 to the intersection of East Federal Street and North Rose Street, north on North Rose Street
3 to the intersection of North Rose Street and East North Avenue, then west on East North
4 Avenue to the intersection of East North Avenue and Harford Avenue, the hours of sale:

5 (i) may not begin before 9 a.m. or end after 10 p.m.; and

6 (ii) may not be extended if they begin later than 9 a.m. or end before
7 10 p.m.

8 (4) FOR A LICENSE HOLDER IN AN AREA BOUNDED AS FOLLOWS:
9 FROM THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND ANNTANA AVENUE, SOUTHWEST
10 ON BELAIR ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF BELAIR ROAD AND FRANKFORD
11 AVENUE, SOUTHEAST ON FRANKFORD AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF
12 FRANKFORD AVENUE AND SIPPLE AVENUE, WEST ON SIPPLE AVENUE TO THE
13 INTERSECTION OF SIPPLE AVENUE AND CRENSHAW AVENUE, SOUTHEAST ON
14 CRENSHAW AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF CRENSHAW AVENUE AND
15 GOODNOW ROAD, SOUTHEAST ON GOODNOW ROAD TO THE INTERSECTION OF
16 GOODNOW ROAD AND SINCLAIR LANE, NORTHEAST ON SINCLAIR LANE TO THE
17 INTERSECTION OF SINCLAIR LANE AND RADECKE AVENUE, WEST ON RADECKE
18 AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF RADECKE AVENUE AND ANNTANA AVENUE,
19 THEN NORTH ON ANNTANA AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF ANNTANA AVENUE
20 AND BELAIR ROAD, THE HOURS OF SALE:

21 (I) MAY NOT BEGIN BEFORE 9 A.M. OR END AFTER 10 P.M.; AND

22 (II) MAY NOT BE EXTENDED IF THEY BEGIN LATER THAN 9 A.M.
23 OR END BEFORE 10 P.M.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
25 1, 2025.
