A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Provisional Drivers’ Licenses – First Aid and**
3 **Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Training Requirement**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring an applicant for a provisional driver’s license to
5 complete successfully, within a certain period of time, a first aid and
6 cardiopulmonary resuscitation training course that meets certain standards;
7 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to develop and make available a list
8 of certain organizations; requiring the Administration to prescribe a certain
9 form; requiring the Administration to provide a certain notice; requiring the
10 Administration to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to a first aid
11 and cardiopulmonary resuscitation training requirement for applicants for
12 provisional drivers’ licenses.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
24 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article – Transportation**

26 16–111.

1 (b) An applicant is entitled to receive a provisional license if the applicant:

2 (1) Meets the minimum age required under § 16-103(c)(2) of this
3 subtitle;

4 (2) Satisfies the learner's instructional permit requirements under §
5 16-105(d)(2), (3), or (4) of this subtitle;

6 (3) Passes a driver skills or driver road examination administered
7 under this subtitle;

8 (4) Surrenders any learner's instructional permit issued to the
9 applicant; [and]

10 (5) **SATISFIES THE FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY**
11 **RESUSCITATION TRAINING REQUIREMENT UNDER § 16-111.3 OF THIS**
12 **SUBTITLE; AND**

13 (6) Pays the fee established under this subtitle.

14 **16-111.3.**

15 (A) **AN APPLICANT FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE SHALL, WITHIN 1 YEAR**
16 **OF APPLICATION, COMPLETE SUCCESSFULLY A FIRST AID AND**
17 **CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING COURSE THROUGH THE**
18 **AMERICAN RED CROSS, THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION, OR A PROGRAM**
19 **WITH EQUIVALENT STANDARDS.**

20 (B) **THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:**

21 (1) **DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAILABLE A LIST OF ORGANIZATIONS**
22 **OFFERING APPROVED FIRST AID AND CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION**
23 **TRAINING COURSES;**

24 (2) **PRESCRIBE A FORM TO BE USED AS EVIDENCE OF**
25 **SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF AN APPROVED FIRST AID AND**
26 **CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING COURSE;**

27 (3) **PROVIDE NOTICE IN DRIVER TRAINING MATERIALS AND BY**
28 **OTHER APPROPRIATE MEANS OF THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT UNDER THIS**
29 **SECTION; AND**

30 (4) **ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF**
31 **THIS SECTION.**

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 2013.
