A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – Voting by Absentee Ballot – Prepaid Postage for Return of**
3 **Ballots**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain envelopes required to be used by voters voting
5 by absentee ballot to return their ballots include prepaid postage; requiring that
6 absentee ballots be accompanied by instructions for the postage of certain absentee
7 ballot envelopes; authorizing the State Board of Elections to reimburse a local board
8 of elections on petition by the local board for the cost of prepaid postage included on
9 absentee ballot envelopes provided to certain voters; and generally relating to
10 prepaid postage for the return of absentee ballots.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Election Law**

19 9–310.

20 (a) (1) This subsection applies only to an absentee ballot that is sent by mail.

21 (2) An absentee ballot shall be enclosed in specially printed envelopes, the
22 form and content of which shall be prescribed by the State Board.

23 (3) (i) A local board may use either two envelopes or three envelopes.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (ii) If two envelopes are used, the inner envelope shall be designated
2 the “ballot/return envelope”, and, when issued, it shall fit inside the envelope designated
3 the “outgoing envelope”.

4 (iii) If three envelopes are used, the innermost envelope shall be
5 designated the “ballot envelope”, which shall fit inside the envelope designated the “return
6 envelope”, both of which, when issued, shall fit inside the envelope designated the “outgoing
7 envelope”.

8 **(IV) THE BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPE DESCRIBED UNDER**
9 **SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH AND THE RETURN ENVELOPE DESCRIBED**
10 **UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH PROVIDED TO A VOTER VOTING**
11 **BY ABSENTEE BALLOT SHALL INCLUDE PREPAID POSTAGE.**

12 **(4) (I) AN ABSENTEE BALLOT SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY**
13 **INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTAGE OF THE BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPE OR THE RETURN**
14 **ENVELOPE.**

15 **(II) THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR POSTAGE SHALL INCLUDE:**

16 **1. A STATEMENT THAT THE BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPE**
17 **OR RETURN ENVELOPE INCLUDES PREPAID POSTAGE AND MAY BE MAILED AS IS;**
18 **AND**

19 **2. DIRECTIONS FOR HOW A VOTER MAY ATTACH**
20 **POSTAGE FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDUCING THE COSTS OF THE LOCAL BOARD.**

21 **[(4)] (5)** When voted and returned to the local board, an absentee ballot
22 shall be enclosed in a ballot envelope or ballot/return envelope, on which has been printed
23 an oath prescribed by the State Board.

24 **(B) ON PETITION OF A LOCAL BOARD, THE STATE BOARD MAY REIMBURSE**
25 **THE LOCAL BOARD FOR THE COST OF PREPAID POSTAGE INCLUDED ON**
26 **BALLOT/RETURN ENVELOPES OR RETURN ENVELOPES PROVIDED TO A VOTER**
27 **VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(3)(IV) OF THIS SECTION.**

28 **[(b)] (C)** If an absentee ballot is sent by the Internet or facsimile transmission,
29 the local board shall provide the voter with an envelope template, the oath prescribed by
30 the State Board, and instructions for marking and returning the absentee ballot.

31 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect**
32 **October 1, 2019.**
