- which the license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor; specifying where and how on the licensed premises beer, wine, and liquor may be sold; stating that a license
- holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license; establishing an annual license fee;
- and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (A) THERE IS A CLASS MT (MOVIE THEATER) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR 4 LICENSE.
- 5 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE OWNER OF A MOVIE
- 6 THEATER.
- 7 (C) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL
- 8 AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION BY A
- 9 PATRON WHO HAS PURCHASED A TICKET TO A CURRENT OR FUTURE SHOWING OF A

- 11 (D) (1) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR DURING 12 NORMAL HOURS OF BUSINESS BUT NOT LATER THAN MIDNIGHT.
- 13 (2) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR MAY BE SOLD ONLY:
- 14 (I) IN SINGLE-SERVE CONTAINERS; AND
- 15 (II) FROM A COUNTER SEPARATE FROM A COUNTER SERVING
- 16 CANDY, POPCORN, AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 17 (E) A LICENSE HOLDER NEED NOT OBTAIN A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER § 18 11–2004 OF THIS TITLE TO PROVIDE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON A SUNDAY.
- 19 **(F)** THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,200.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
