- 2 Anne Arundel County Alcoholic Beverages Class MT (Movie Theater) License
- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) beer, wine, and liquor beer and wine license in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the Board of License 4 5 Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to issue the license to the owner of a movie 6 theater who holds a certain certification; authorizing a license holder to sell beer, 7 wine, and liquor beer and wine to certain patrons at retail at the place described in 8 the license for on-premises consumption; specifying the hours during which the 9 license holder may sell beer, wine, and liquor beer and wine; specifying where and 10 how on the licensed premises beer, wine, and liquor beer and wine may be sold; 11 stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license; specifying that 12 the license holder is subject to certain alcohol awareness requirements; establishing 13 an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel 14 County.

- 6 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

- 8 (A) THERE IS A CLASS MT (MOVIE THEATER) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR
- 9 <u>BEER AND WINE</u> LICENSE.
- 10 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE OWNER OF A MOVIE
- 11 THEATER THAT HOLDS A CROWD CONTROL TRAINING CERTIFICATION.
- 12 (C) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR BEER AND
- 13 WINE AT RETAIL AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE FOR ON-PREMISES
- 14 CONSUMPTION BY A PATRON WHO HAS PURCHASED A TICKET TO A CURRENT OR
- 15 FUTURE SHOWING OF A MOVIE ON THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- 16 (D) (1) A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR BEER OR
- 17 WINE DURING NORMAL HOURS OF BUSINESS BUT NOT LATER THAN BETWEEN THE
- 18 HOURS OF 4 P.M. AND MIDNIGHT.
- 19 **BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR** BEER AND WINE MAY BE SOLD ONLY:
- 20 (I) IN SINGLE-SERVE CONTAINERS; AND
- 21 (II) FROM A COUNTER SEPARATE FROM A COUNTER SERVING
- 22 CANDY, POPCORN, FOOD AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 23 (E) A LICENSE HOLDER NEED NOT OBTAIN A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER §
- 24 11-2004 OF THIS TITLE TO PROVIDE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON A SUNDAY.
- 25 (F) THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS
- 26 REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 11–1902.1 OF THIS TITLE.
- 27 (F) (G) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,200.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
- 29 1, 2020.
