## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class MT (Movie Theater) License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class MT (movie theater) ~~beer, wine, and liquor~~ beer  
4 and wine license in Anne Arundel County; authorizing the Board of License  
5 Commissioners for Anne Arundel County to issue the license to the owner of a movie  
6 theater who holds a certain certification; authorizing a license holder to sell ~~beer,~~  
7 ~~wine, and liquor~~ beer and wine to certain patrons at retail at the place described in  
8 the license for on-premises consumption; specifying the hours during which the  
9 license holder may sell ~~beer, wine, and liquor~~ beer and wine; specifying where and  
10 how on the licensed premises ~~beer, wine, and liquor~~ beer and wine may be sold;  
11 stating that a license holder need not obtain a certain Sunday license; specifying that  
12 the license holder is subject to certain alcohol awareness requirements; establishing  
13 an annual license fee; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel  
14 County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

11–102.

This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

**11–1006.1.**

(A) **THERE IS A CLASS MT (MOVIE THEATER) ~~BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR~~  
BEER AND WINE LICENSE.**

(B) **THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE OWNER OF A MOVIE  
THEATER THAT HOLDS A CROWD CONTROL TRAINING CERTIFICATION.**

(C) **THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL ~~BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR~~ BEER AND  
WINE AT RETAIL AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE FOR ON–PREMISES  
CONSUMPTION BY A PATRON WHO HAS PURCHASED A TICKET TO A CURRENT OR  
FUTURE SHOWING OF A MOVIE ON THE LICENSED PREMISES.**

(D) (1) **A LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL ~~BEER, WINE, OR LIQUOR~~ BEER OR  
WINE ~~DURING NORMAL HOURS OF BUSINESS BUT NOT LATER THAN~~ BETWEEN THE  
HOURS OF 4 P.M. AND MIDNIGHT.**

(2) **~~BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR~~ BEER AND WINE MAY BE SOLD ONLY:**

(I) **IN SINGLE–SERVE CONTAINERS; AND**

(II) **FROM A COUNTER SEPARATE FROM A COUNTER SERVING  
~~CANDY, POPCORN,~~ FOOD AND NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.**

(E) **A LICENSE HOLDER NEED NOT OBTAIN A SUNDAY LICENSE UNDER §  
11–2004 OF THIS TITLE TO PROVIDE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON A SUNDAY.**

(F) **THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUBJECT TO THE ALCOHOL AWARENESS  
REQUIREMENTS UNDER § 11–1902.1 OF THIS TITLE.**

~~(F)~~ (G) **THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$1,200.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
1, 2020.
