2 **Child Abuse and Neglect – Memorandum of Understanding With Military**
3 **Family Advocacy Program**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain local departments of social services to enter into a
5 memorandum of understanding with a certain military family advocacy program;
6 establishing certain requirements for a memorandum of understanding under this
7 Act; defining a certain term; and generally relating to child abuse and neglect.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Family Law**

16 **5–705.5.**

17 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “MILITARY FAMILY ADVOCACY PROGRAM” MEANS**
18 **THE PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**
19 **TO ADDRESS CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT AND DOMESTIC ABUSE IN MILITARY**

1 FAMILIES.

2 (B) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT THAT HAS A UNITED STATES MILITARY
3 INSTALLATION LOCATED WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION SHALL ENTER INTO A
4 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE MILITARY FAMILY ADVOCACY
5 PROGRAM AT THE LOCAL MILITARY INSTALLATION.

6 (C) A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL
7 ESTABLISH PROCEDURES AND PROTOCOLS FOR:

8 (1) IDENTIFYING AN INDIVIDUAL ALLEGED TO HAVE COMMITTED
9 ABUSE OR NEGLECT AS MILITARY PERSONNEL;

10 (2) REPORTING BY A LOCAL DEPARTMENT TO A MILITARY FAMILY
11 ADVOCACY PROGRAM WHEN AN INVESTIGATION IMPLICATING MILITARY
12 PERSONNEL HAS BEEN INITIATED; AND

13 (3) MAINTAINING CONFIDENTIALITY REQUIREMENTS UNDER STATE
14 AND FEDERAL LAW.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2021.
