- A court may not assess costs on a person or governmental unit to whom a restitution obligor has been ordered to pay restitution:
- 19 (1) for recording and indexing AS A MONEY JUDGMENT an order of restitution [as a money judgment in the court in which the judgment of restitution was] 21 issued BY ANY COURT IN THE STATE:
- 22 (2) for recording and indexing a notice of lien that the District Court 23 forwards to a circuit court; or



- 1 (3) for filing a notice of satisfaction.
