3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of sanitary commissioners in the

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Environment**

14 9–622.

15 (a) (1) The sanitary commission of each single county district consists of  
16 the following numbers of sanitary commissioners, each appointed by the governing  
17 body of the member county:
