2 **Maryland Small Business Retirement Savings Board – Membership – Alteration**

5 the membership of the Maryland Small Business Retirement Savings Board.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Labor and Employment**

19 12–201.

20 (a) (1) There is a Maryland Small Business Retirement Savings Board.

21 (b) The Board consists of the following members:

22 (1) the State Treasurer, or the State Treasurer’s designee;

1 (2) the Secretary of Labor, or the Secretary's designee; [and]

2 (3) THE COMPTROLLER, OR THE COMPTROLLER'S DESIGNEE; AND

3 [(3)] (4) nine members with expertise in retirement programs and
4 benefits, investments, financial systems and controls, or small business, appointed as
5 follows:

6 (i) three members, appointed by the Governor;

7 (ii) three members, appointed by the President of the Senate; and

8 (iii) three members, appointed by the Speaker of the House of
9 Delegates.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2025.
