- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain physicians who perform abortions or certain 4 hospitals, facilities, and institutions in which an abortion is performed to report the 5 abortion to the Maryland Department of Health; requiring that the report be made 6 on a certain form, be completed by a certain physician, hospital, facility, or 7 institution, be transmitted annually to the Vital Statistics Administration within a 8 certain period of time, and include certain information; providing that the report 9 may include certain information but may not include certain identifying information; 10 establishing certain penalties; requiring the Department to adopt certain 11 regulations; authorizing the State Board of Physicians to take certain disciplinary 12 actions against a licensee who violates certain provisions of this Act; defining a 13 certain term; and generally relating to the reporting of information about abortions.
