Driver's Licenses - Learner's Permits - Minimum Duration $\mathbf{2}$

- 3 FOR the purpose of reducing the period of time that certain individuals who are at least a certain age and who hold a learner's instructional permit are required to wait before 4 $\mathbf{5}$ taking certain examinations for a provisional driver's license; making a stylistic 6 change; and generally relating to requirements for obtaining a provisional driver's 7 license.
