

28 (ii) The scholarship shall be paid directly to the educational 29 institution that the student attends.

30 (iii) [A student may receive not more than two scholarships of \$3,500 ach regardless of the number of terms the student serves as the student representative of the county board.

- 1 (iv)] The scholarship may not be considered compensation for the 2 purpose of calculating taxable income.
- 3 (2) On the submission of expense vouchers, the student representative is 4 entitled to reimbursement for travel and other expenses incurred in the performance of 5 official duties for the county board.
- 6 (3) The student representative is not entitled to any compensation or payment other than that specified under paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection for work as the student representative of the county board.
